Course Description:

Intermediate level course - level B1 of the CEFR. Refinement of reading, writing, and speaking skills through the study of contemporary literature and other authentic documents of the French-speaking world. It is built on a communicative approach to language acquisition where the learning and the assessments are task-based. This course will put emphasis on developing students' opinions on different topics such as traveling, music, social media, and more. Students are expected to be able to interact in French in a limited set of situations and get a grasp on the intermediate notions of the grammar of French (parts of speech, agreements, conjugation, tenses, spelling, pronunciation, etc.). Prerequisite: French 12 or any A2 level course. Not suitable for French immersion students.
