## Course Description:

English 112 is designed to develop reading and writing skills for use throughout your university career. The course objective is to introduce you to the ways in which scholars think about, undertake, and communicate the results of their research. It is structured to cover the essay-writing process through reading strategies, summary, analysis, persuasion, research methods, revision, and documentation. It will also include editing exercises designed to assist you in constructing sentences appropriate for university-level research writing. As this is not a course in English language skills, the expectation is that your competence in grammar and academic style will be high to enable the writing of academic papers that are significantly error free. While this course is not discipline specific, its aim is to make you aware of scholarly conventions in general and empower you to write and research successfully within whichever discipline you choose to pursue.
